Should your child have any special medical or physical needs you are required to advise the Club in writing.

Should physical contact by a third party be required during model flying for instructional or any other purpose, this will be explained to you and you will be required to record your agreement in writing defining the types and limits of contact.

Should the Club wish to use a photographic image of your child, the Club will follow the guidelines laid down by the NSPCC Child Protection in Sport Unit which in simple terms are:

- If the child is named in full, a photograph will not be used;
- If a photograph is used, the child's name will not be used in full;
- Written parental consent will be obtained before any image of a young person is used. This ensures that parents are aware the image of their child is representing the sport.

This membership form must be countersigned by the parent or guardian if the applicant is under 18 years of age or by the authorised carer of a vulnerable adult, thereby signifying acceptance of the conditions of membership.
